



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### HOW TO BOOK

To make your reservation a deposit of 50% is required together with a completed booking form signed by yourself, which states you have read and agreed to the terms and conditions set forth. Confirmation will be issued upon receipt, but will be subject to the completion of a medical questionnaire.

### PAYMENT SCHEDULE

50%	On reservation
50%	No later than 21 days prior to departure

### VOYAGE COSTS

Include: one berth on a surveyed square rigged sailing vessel, professionally crewed in accordance with survey requirements for the duration of the cruise, plus three meals per day whilst on board.

Not included in cost: Bar bill, individual arrangements and travel to or from point of departure or arrival, special dietary requirements (not including vegetarian), medications.

### CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

If your booking cannot be accepted for whatever reason, all monies paid will be refunded. If you cancel within 30 days of booking, your deposit will be refunded in full, less a 5% administration fee.

Cancellations received less than 21 days before departure will only be refunded if the berth can be resold to another party, less the 5% administration fee.

If the R. Tucker Thompson for any reason cancels the trip, including due to severe weather conditions, all monies will be refunded in full.

For protection of passengers and the R. Tucker Thompson, all monies will be held in an escrow account until 1 week prior to departure date.

### ITINERARY CHANGES

Every effort will be made to adhere to the itinerary. However changes to the published itinerary may occur as a result of adverse weather conditions. Changes might include rearranging the order of visits, cancellation of some shore visits, and travel to alternative appropriate locations.

If winds are unfavourable the vessel may make use of her engine to maintain schedules. All decisions will be that of the Master and no refunds will be available if the itinerary cannot be followed precisely.

### ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION

The R. Tucker Thompson will be happy to arrange accommodation locally for you prior to and on completion of your chosen voyage should you wish.

### HEALTH, FITNESS AND AGE

All participants must be in good health and must complete a confidential medical questionnaire. Passengers are required to have a reasonable degree of mobility given that the voyage will be coastal in



nature and they will need to be capable of transition above and below decks. Accommodation is comfortable but bunk style in nature and while every effort will be made to billet berths according to age and ability, it should be recognised that the ship is not a luxury vessel. There is no upper age limitation, but an adult must accompany each child under the age of 16. Passengers over 70 years old will require a GP's certificate confirming they can undertake the voyage.

## YOUR ROLE ON THE VOYAGE

This is an historic cruise where the emphasis is placed on your enjoyment and learning. However, participation enhances this and consequently you will be encouraged to participate in the sailing of the ship, learning about and being involved in shipboard life. Allowance is made for age and abilities. However, participation is NOT compulsory and passengers may chose to simply relax. As the ship will be anchored nightly, only an anchor watch will be required and passengers are welcome to be involved if they wish.

## ALCOHOL POLICY

Beer and wine is available for sale on board and we run a bar tab for the voyage. Guests are also permitted to bring their own but can only be consumed while the bar is open. This is at the Masters' discretion and safety considerations will prevail. Bar bills are to be settled at the end of each voyage.
